March 2025 meeting minutes

Working group updates

- P. Panza presented updates on working group activities for the last 3 months.
 - The Enhance working group carried out trail corridor evaluations in Winter Garden and Oakland and is scheduling two more in Gotha and Windermere.
 - The Trail Network Development Working Group will soon be reviewing Oakland's HWOTC Trail Grant Program application for \$100,000 to support construction of the Sadler Trail Loop.
 - The working group has also continued to support Gotha in assembling a Lake Down Loop application.



FY 26 Facilitation Scope of Services

- P. Panza presented the proposed FY26 scope, cost shares, and budget, along with confirmation that Oakland, Ocoee, and Winter Garden have all confirmed inclusion of funding in their draft budgets. Members were happy with the scope at this stage and directed BWCF to work with the Executive Committee to finalize and approve it.
